

MODULAR EXPANSION UNIT for the CODE 3 RLS System

DESCRIPTION:

The RLS Modular Expansion Unit provides an easy method of interconnecting the RLS System components and allows you to get the most from your RLS System while protecting your equipment from damage which might be caused by non-CODE 3 equipment. This unit is especially desirable with RLS installations featuring any or all of the following RLS System components: Dual amplifiers, RLS Serial Interface, RLS Auxiliary Relay Module, NP130 Spotlight Control, RLS Virtual Control Head software application running on a Laptop PC. Using the RLS Modular Expansion Unit allows redundant control of the RLS system using either the RLS Control Head or the RLS Virtual Control Head software application.

OPERATION:

Refer to the appropriate user instruction manual for details on the configuration and operation of the RLS Siren System and optional devices.

MOUNTING & WIRING:

The connection detail is shown in Fig. 1 below. Mount the RLS Modular Expansion unit near the RLS System components using Velcro, double sided mounting tape or screws. Connect each RLS component to its labeled jack on the RLS Modular Expansion unit using the modular cables supplied with the system.

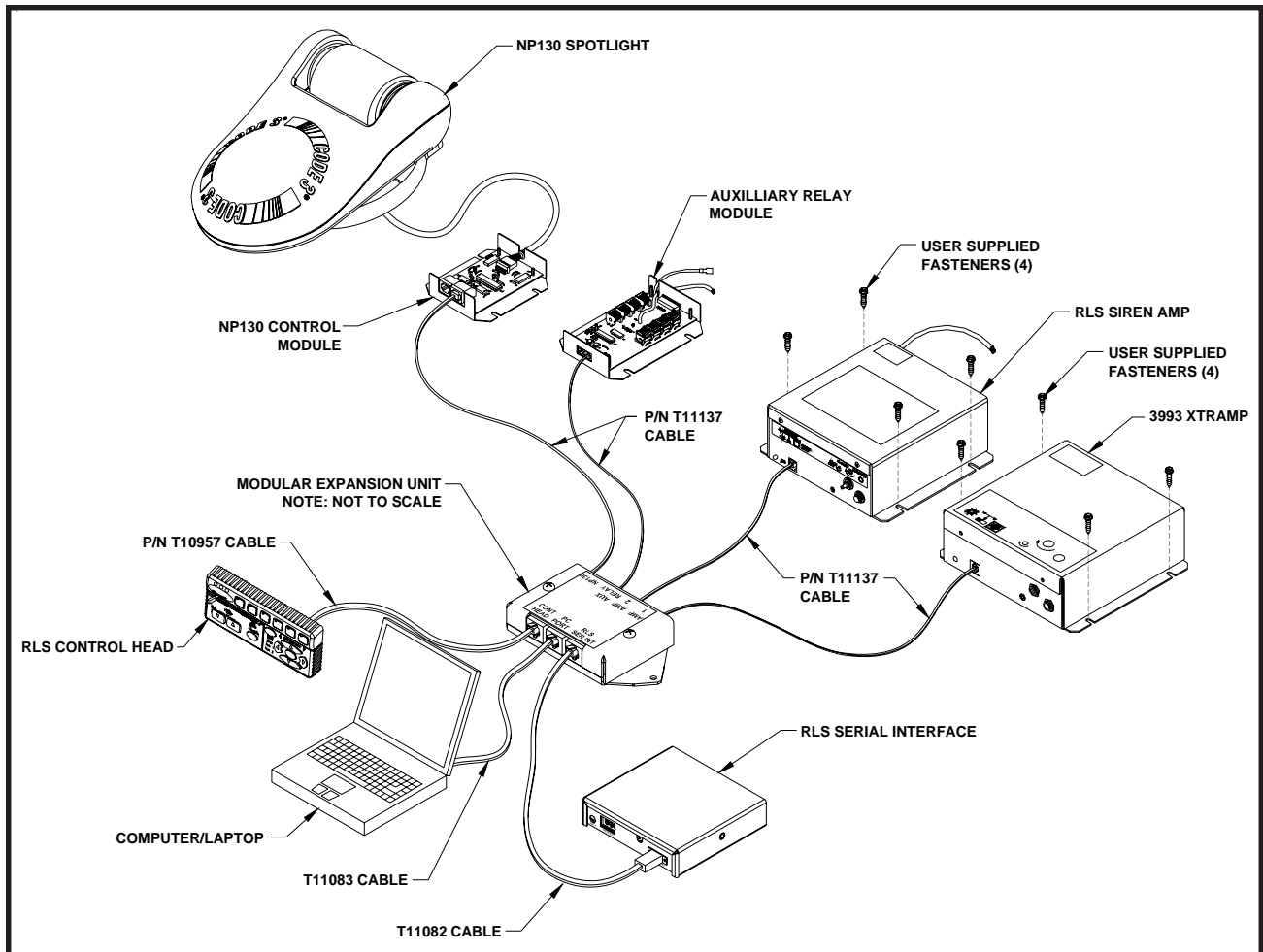
